Patti Kitching of the California Court of Appeals, 2nd District, and Judge Cheryl Johnson of the Texas Court of Criminal Appeals.

After law school, Mr. Hansen gained additional specialization in tax law, earning his LL.M. in Taxation from New York University. He served as an in-house tax advisor to the International Health Foundation, a 501(c)(3) organization, helping them re-instate their tax exemption. He also worked as an Attorney Advisor to the Social Security Administration before joining ScottHulse as an associate attorney in the Firm's Tax Law practice group.

Mr. Hansen is active in the El Paso Community, serving as Chairman of the local Board of the American Red Cross and a Board Member for the local chapter of the Boy Scouts of America.
